

# DIVISION GOLF

A Division  
Game



TWO-PLAYER GAME

## Materials:

- deck of cards numbers 2-9
- optional: counters

## Objective:

Be the player with the lowest score (or the fewest remainders)

## Instructions:

- Shuffle the cards and place them face down.
- On their turn, a player draws 3 cards and places them face up.
- The player creates a 2-digit number and a 1-digit number to make a division problem. **Example:** 3, 5 & 5 – player can make  $35 \div 5$  to get a score of 0 (because there are no remainders).
- The remainder is the player's score for that round.
- If there is no remainder, the player scores zero points.
- The player with the lowest score after 9 rounds is the winner!
